- Lt Sir Marmaduke Charles Henry Joseph Blennerhassett. Royal Navy Volunteers Reserve.
Killed in Action on the 25th of May 1940. Aged 37.
- Lieutenant Walter George Hugh Testaferrata Bonham. Royal Navy.
Killed in Action on the 3rd May 1943. Aged 23.
- Lieutenant Anthony Joseph Davidson. Royal Navy.
Killed in Action on the 25th February 1944. Aged 22.
- Lieutenant Mark Vincent Ebel, George Medal (GM). Royal Navy Volunteer Reserve.
Killed on Active Service on the 24th of February 1943. Aged 22.
- Sub Lieutenant (Acting) Patrick Purcell Fitzgerald. Royal Navy Volunteer Reserve.
Killed on Active Service on the 16th of October 1941. Aged 23.
- Laurence Francis Gahan
Died at Sea on the 20th of July 1942. Aged 27.
- Major Albert William Meldon. Royal Marines.
Died on Active Service on the 11th of April 1943. Aged 24.
- Rear Admiral Gerald Charles Muirhead-Gould, DSC. Royal Navy.
Died on Active Service on the 26th of June 1945. Aged 56.
- Steward Malcolm Myles Roberts. Merchant Navy.
Killed in Action on the 16th of March 1942. Aged 24.
