AIMS

Our programme for international pupils provides them with an excellent education and gives pupils the confidence and study skills to prepare for onward study at Downside or elsewhere. We prepare pupils for A-Level post-16 education in the UK through a focus on core subjects that are fundamental to success in later life. We provide pupils with a true UK boarding school education and atmosphere as exemplified by the British education system and enjoyed by all pupils at Downside.

HEALTH CENTRE

Located in the heart of the school, with beautiful views over the school grounds and Abbey, the Health & Wellbeing Centre is fully accessible to all pupils and is always busy, with pupils using the Health Centre for a wide range of health and emotional wellbeing needs.

We endeavour to identify and respond to the health needs of all our pupils from their first day at Downside to the end of their time in our school community. The Health Centre has a holistic vibe which reflects its nurse-led approach offering a provision to support physical, emotional and social needs of all our pupils, with the ability to provide 24 hour care should it be required.

SPORT

Pupils will have full access to all school facilities. Pupils will have plenty of opportunities to make full use of indoor and outdoor sport and exercise facilities within the School campus. All pupils will be encouraged to find a sport or physical activity in which they can participate, excel and learn the values of being part of a team.

The main sports for boys are rugby, hockey, cricket, tennis and athletics. The main sports for girls are hockey, netball, cricket, tennis and athletics. Many pupils can also participate in badminton, basketball, cross country, football, golf, rugby 7's, swimming & table tennis, with regular fixtures throughout the year.

WEEKEND

There will always be a wide variety of off-site trips offered to all pupils. This will include trips to Bath and Bristol, cinema, bowling, Stonehenge and other local tourist attractions. On-site activities will include the usual range of exciting options including kayaking, archery and sports.

CATERING

We proudly partner with Holroyd Howe, an award-winning caterer, to manage food at Downside. We understand that good nutrition is a vital part of your child's wellbeing and happiness. We pride ourselves on including input from pupils, parents, staff and suppliers to ensure that every child looks forward to, and enjoys, every meal.

FACILITIES

Downside's 500 acres (202 hectares) site is set in the countryside yet within easy reach of Bath, Bristol & London. Our facilities include a 450 seat theatre, an indoor heated swimming pool, squash courts, gymnasium, hockey, football, rugby & cricket pitches, tennis courts and a health centre.

PASTORAL CARE

Downside is proud of the outstanding level of pastoral care it provides for student health and well-being. The School is well-known for its strong sense of community and for the supportive relationships between the age groups and with staff. The Houses sit at the heart of this and provide the best possible support for both boarding and day pupils to allow them to develop true Christian values.

GUARDIANSHIP

ENGLISH LANGUAGE OPTIONS

Our programme allows all pupils to advance their level of English and prepares them for further education and careers in this global language. Tuition is given by highly skilled and qualified staff in the EAL (English as an Additional Language) Department, which enables pupils to take the most suitable Secure English Language Tests (SELT) which align with the individual needs and levels of pupils. Pupils will benefit from a rigorous timetable, gaining one or more internationally recognised English qualifications.

It is preferable for pupils who enrol in our programme to have a Common European Framework level of B2, but on arrival all pupils will sit the Oxford Placement Tests, as part of a needs analysis, so that the most appropriate SELT can be determined.

Pupils can potentially take IELTS Academic or General, Cambridge C1 Advance, Cambridge IGCSE English as a Second Language (0991) or Cambridge B2 First For Schools. Some pupils will be able to take two or three qualifications over one year, with close communications between our EAL Department, pupils and their parents/guardians.

ADMISSIONS PROCESS

Our admissions process is designed to be uncomplicated. Applicants are required to complete the online Registration Form and to submit the following documents:

- A copy of the applicant's passport.
- A copy of their most recent School Report.

Following receipt of the completed registration form, candidates will be required to complete entrance assessments. These include a written English paper, online CAT 4 assessments and an interview. Following these, we will offer a guaranteed place or decline the application.
